







WHY

As a port professional, gaining a thorough understanding of the responsibilities and functions of each party in the supply chain is crucial, as well as the principles of value-added logistics and efficient supply chain management. The curriculum on Port Logistics emphasizes the importance of providing exceptional customer service through the efficient, cost-effective handling and distribution of goods.

FOR WHOM

The Port Logistics course is designed for port authority executives responsible for developing logistic strategies and operations. Additionally, executives of freight forwarding and logistics companies that specialise in maritime, rail, and road transport, as well as terminal operators and warehouse managers, gain from this course as well. Officials from government ministries focused on transport, maritime affairs, and customs benefit from this curriculum.

Course fee: Rs 100 000

This course fee covers the course material, airport pick-up/ drop-off, accommodation (5 nights in a twin sharing room) and all meals and beverages (no GTS included)

WHAT
